- ◆ **Entry for Multiple Tournaments**
Players participating in THE WORLD 2017 STAGE4 -PREMIUM- cannot participate in the concurrent event Trios 01 Festival as both are held at the same time.

Players participating in the U-22 2017 Finals cannot participate in the concurrent event Trios 01 Festival as both are held at the same time.

Repeated entry for the same tournament is not allowed.
- ◆ **DARTSLIVE CARD Data**
DARTSLIVE CARD registered during the entry is required on the day of the event.
If the data is transferred to another DARTSLIVE CARD after the entry, please use the new DARTSLIVE CARD on the day of the event.

If you have submitted the DARTSLIVE CARD ID with no rating during the entry, please have the rating ready by July 31, 2017.

● Important Notice about the Tournament ●

- ◆ **FLIGHT**
FLIGHT represents the level of one's darts skills. The FLIGHT will be determined based on the rating of your registered DARTSLIVE CARD.
There will be 3 FLIGHTs for Trios 01 Festival and 10 FLIGHTs for Doubles 01 Festival.
Please check our website for The Entry List and assigned FLIGHT List, the lists will be release on the website after the entries close.
- ◆ **Round Robin**
Round Robin is a tournament which 3 to 4 teams in the bloc plays against all other teams in the same bloc.
Top 2 teams of each Round Robin will advance to the Finals.
Please check the DARTSLIVE member page for the machine (board) number of your Round Robin.
- ◆ **Sandbagging**
Sandbagging rules is applied to this tournament. Players whose tournament stats considerably exceed their pre-registered stats or the standard defined by each tournament may become subject to disqualification in accordance with the Sandbagging rule.
A team will be disqualified if the DARTSLIVE CARD team rating exceeds the pre-registered rating by more than average of 3.
When a team disqualify, the team ranked below the disqualified team will advance to the Finals.
*Sandbagging rule will not be applied in the U-22 and THE WORLD STAGE 4 -PREMIUM-.
- ◆ **Check-in**
Please check-in at the TouchLive in the venue using the registered DARTSLIVE CARD on the day of the tournament.
Please be sure to bring your registered DARTSLIVE CARD.
If you forget to bring your DARTSLIVE CARD, please go to the information in the venue.
Transferring your data into another DARTSLIVE CARD will require a long time, please note that this may result to cancel the participation in the event you are registered.
- ◆ **Cloakroom/ Coat check**
There will be no space to place your luggage in the venue. Please drop off your luggage at the cloakroom/ coat check.
Valuables and precious items must be kept by your side at all times.
- ◆ **Tournament Flow**
After check-in, please check the DARTSLIVE member page and proceed to the assigned machine (board).
When you arrive at the machine (board) please make sure your team is on the Round Robin Form and check off the checkbox.

The first game will begin after the opening ceremony.

Please be sure to use your DARTSLIVE card during the games.
- *When playing without the DARTSLIVE CARD, the game is considered a default and the team may lose the game.
For the Finals, please check the monitor at the control for your team and assigned machine (board) number, then pick up the match card and proceed to the assigned machine (board) and start the game.

● Rules ●

- DARTSLIVE2 is employs as the official darts machine for this tournament.
Throwing orders can not be changed during games for both Doubles 01 Festival and Trios 01 Festival.
- Each player gets 2 practice throws before the game.
Only plastic tips are allowed during the entire tournament.
- If a player wishes to throw from a position outside the throw line, they must stay behind the extended throw line.
No throws will be acknowledged if a player's front foot crosses the throw line
- If a Player has a medical needs to utilize any assistive devices, such devices should not cross the throw line.
- Players must use the DARTSLIVE CARD during the game.
- In case the game is interrupted such as by a power failure, the machine should be restored to the last known point, restoring the match. If the restoration is not possible, the LEG will be replayed.
- Throwing order will be decided by the coin toss function.
The loser of the previous LEG throws first in the 2nd LEG.
The coin toss function will be use to decide the throwing order of the 3rd LEG.
*For Doubles 01 Festival SA FLIGHT, the throwing order will be decided by corking.
The coin toss function will be used for deciding who throws the cork first.
- For 01 games, if both teams cannot finish the game at the round limit, the game will be a tie game and the winner will be decided by corking.
- The first thrower of the LEG will throw the cork first.
For CRICKET, if the scores are tied at the final round, the winner will be decided by corking.
The first thrower of the LEG will throw the cork first.

● Cautions ●

- Players who engage in any of the following acts will be disqualified.
1. Team that disqualify due to the sandbagging rule for exceeding the pre-registered team rating by more than average of 3.
2. Actions that obstructs throws of the other team players such as shouting when cheering.
3. Intentionally delaying the game and engaging in any other acts that are disturbing to the operations of the event.
4. Committing any acts against public order and morals and/or acts that lack the sense of sportsmanship.
- Players cannot entry in the following two tournaments together as they are held at the same time. THE WORLD and Trios 01 Festival, U-22 and Doubles 01 Festival.
- Players who are participating in this event grant absolute right to the organizer to use pictures and video images filmed during the event for advertising and commercial purposes without limitations on time period, place and/or methods.
- Player under 16 must be accompanied by a legal guardian or bring the consent form signed by a legal guardian.
Please be noted that the law obligates all players under 16 to be accompanied by a legal guardian. In addition, all players under 16 will be asked to leave the venue after 10 PM even they are playing in the game.

Player who drives to the venue must receiving the "Driver" tag at the check-in. Please wear it at all times where it is recognizable by the event organizer.

Players under 20 must receive the "U-22" tag at the check-in. Please wear it at all times where it is recognizable by the event organizer.

If a driver is reported drinking alcohol, or a player under 20 is reported drinking alcohol or smoking, they will be disqualified from the tournament.
In such case, the legal guardian and players who encouraged the actions will also be disqualified.

Taking pictures is permitted during the tournament.
However, when obstructing the game by the use of flashes or pictures or videos taken for business purposes will be confiscated and prohibit publishing by the event organizer.
- The event organizer reserves the right to remove or refuse any players who are found to be impeding to the event or event progress from participating in the tournament.

Those players who compete in this tournament are deemed to have agreed to the aforementioned event organizer's rights.
